Dear Brian,

Thank you for meeting with Joan Brannigan and other members of Women's International League for Peace and Freedom (St. Louis Branch and at-large). I've attached the photo, to jog your memory. I apologize that it has taken me so long to get back to you; I've been on the road speaking about the West Lake Landfill and other issues during the WILPF-US Nuclear-Free-Future tour, including a few days lobbying with Alliance for Nuclear Accountability in DC, and only now am I catching my breath. You asked me to write to you about the various requests I made. They're listed online, along with backup materials to explain our positions, at <http://prop1.org/wilpf/2017/lobbying.info.links.htm>

While in DC, I stopped by Representative Clay's office, hoping to be able to meet with someone, and dropped off the petitions (166 signatures) that WILPF members collected in St. Louis at the Earth Day events April 22-23 (see attachment 2). I wrote a cover note, to be delivered via Pauline Jamry, asking Representative Clay to once again co-sponsor the "Nuclear Weapons Abolition and Economic and Energy Conversion Act" with Eleanor Holmes Norton when she re-introduces it, which she says she will be doing soon. We were thrilled that Mr. Clay co-sponsored it as HR-1976 last session.

We hope to hear that Representative Clay has let Ms. Norton know that he will co-sponsor again, perhaps when it is introduced, if Ms. Norton agrees?

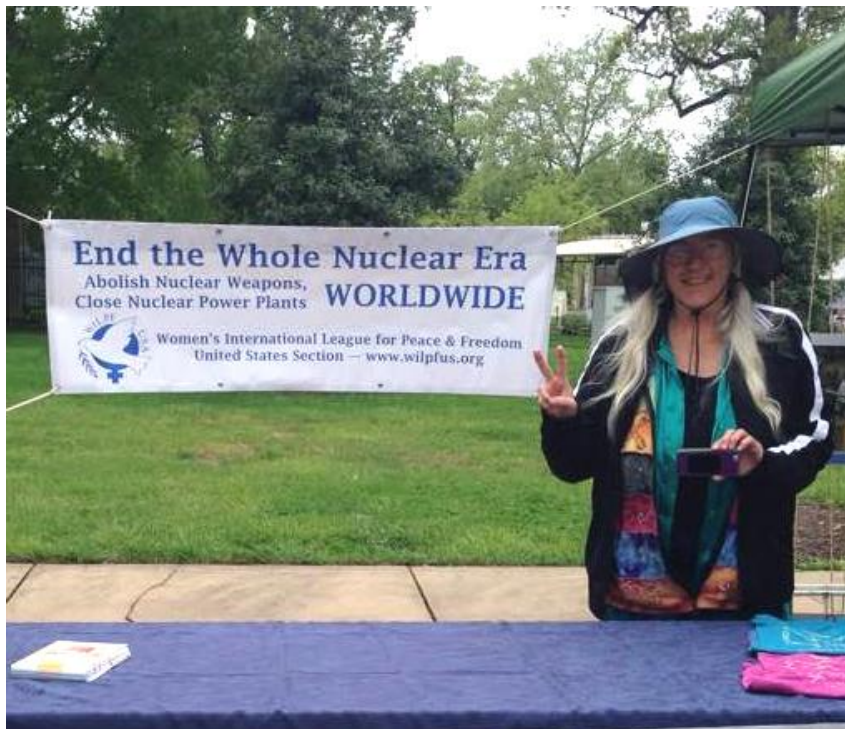
