Thank you for meeting with Joan Brannigan and other members of Women's International League for Peace and Freedom (St. Louis Branch and at-large). I've attached the photo, to jog your memory. I apologize that it has taken me so long to get back to you; I've been on the road speaking about the West Lake Landfill and other issues during the WILPF-US Nuclear-Free-Future tour, including a few days lobbying with Alliance for Nuclear Accountability in DC, and only now am I catching my breath. 


